Palm Sunday – April 1-2, regular Mass times

- Palms ordered.

- There will be a processional.
- Passion to be done in parts (with music interlude?)
- It was discussed that the readings cannot be displayed on the screens, however, Jeff will check with St. Pius on printing the readings as they do.
 Update since meeting per Pat: Father looked on the <u>usccb.org</u> website and found that there is permission for a one time print, not posted electronically.
 That's what we're going with.
- Two servers needed.
- Mics need to be set up for the reading of the Passion including mics for people leading the crowd. (Father Robert, Deacon Jeff, crowd, voices)

Chrism Mass – Tuesday, April 4

Representatives from St. Edward were not invited this year. It is done on a rotation basis.

Holy Thursday – April 6, 6:30 PM Mass

- Readings: 1, 3, 5, Epistle, Gospel.
- There will be a Sprinkling with Holy Water.

Per Father Robert, there will not be a Sprinkling during the Easter season Masses.
