NEWSLETTER / MEETING MINUTES

Aug. 18, 2024

- The meeting was held after the burger/brat fry. It was called to order by Grand Knight Ervin Van Camp at 11:30 and was opened with the Our Father prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance to the United States of America. Also present were our Duty Grand Knight Vic Salm, Trustee Frank Witt, Trustee Randy Van Camp, Treasurer Fred Ringel, Jerry Ebben, Kevin Flood, and Financial Secretary Mark Vosters.
- The May 19, 2024 meeting minutes were read and approved.
- Treasurer Report: Fred provided typed reports on both checking accounts for the periods of May 19 to June 16 and June 16 to July 21. He reported on the limited activity from July 21 to August 18, and both checking accounts balances were verified. The semi-annual audit was complete and submitted on August 2. The profit from today's cook-out was \$130.00. As reported in May, the rose sale on Mother's Day collected \$662.00. We now know the cost of the roses was \$385 leaving a profit of \$277 available for donations.
- A motion was made by Vic and seconded by Jerry to pay the Supreme per capita of \$150.75. All approved.
- Vic made a motion, seconded by Mark, to donate the proceeds of \$130 from today's brat fry plus \$370 for a total of \$500 to a one of our K of C and parish member to help cover medical expenses. All approved.
- We will collect Coats for Kids and adults again this fall. Vic will provide the boxes for donors to put the garments in.
- Frank reported that Dave, the parish technical expert, would like to interview Farmer.
- We received thank you notes from Ms. Marian Look for the retirement gift we gave her, from the school teachers for their end of year luncheon, and from ProLife Wi. for the \$200 donation in support of the March for Life in Madison on June 15.

- After a motion to adjourn by Vic and seconded by Frank, the meeting adjourned at 12:25, closing with the Father McGivney prayer.
