NEWSLETTER / MEETING MINUTES
September 24, 2023

- The meeting was held after the burger/brat fry which was held after the 8:45 mass. It was called to order by Grand Knight Erv Van Camp at 10:55 and was opened with the Our Father prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance to the United States of America. Also present were our Deputy Grand Knight Vic Salm, Warden Dan Kreutzberg, Trustee Frank Witt, Treasurer Fred Ringel, Trustee Randy Van Camp, Kevin Flood, Wayne Van Straten, and Financial Secretary Mark Vosters.
- The August 20, 2023 meeting minutes were read and approved.
- Treasurer Report: Fred provided a typed report on both checking accounts for the period of August 24 to Sep. 24. There were 2 withdrawals from the expense account for a total of \$348.50 (Supreme per capita of \$148.50 and \$200.00 for the Aug. 20 brat fry expenses). There was one deposit of \$200 from the brat fry proceeds to cover the above \$200 expense. In the charity account, there were no withdrawals. There was one deposit of \$174.00 from the profit of the Aug. 20 brat fry. Note that the profit was \$224 but \$50 was paid in cash for Carol Felton's Memorial. Today's burger/brat fry grossed \$435.00. After expenses of \$140.00, net profit was \$295.00. \$200 of scrip was purchased to buy supplies for this brat fry, so \$60 is available for purchase of supplies for the pancake breakfast planned for Oct. 29.
- Vic motioned, seconded by Randy to pay Mark back for the \$150 of Culvers scrip he purchased to provide 15 \$10.00 gift cards for the NE family night drawings. All approved.
- Vic motioned, seconded by Fred, to donate \$150 of today's brat fry proceeds to the Harvest Moon Festival. All approved.
- Vic motioned, seconded by Mark to donate \$100 of today's proceeds to VIDA. All approved
- A motion was made by Fred, seconded by Vic to donate the proceeds from the planned Oct. 29 pancake breakfast toward the purchased of an ultrasound machine for the Clarity Clinic of SW Wisconsin. This ultrasound machine purchase is being sponsored by K of C council 1386 in Platteville. They hope to raise \$20,000. Motion was approved.
- Vic will bring the cardboard boxes for coat collection to church. Mark will ask Erin to publish information to the parish about the coat collection and the donations we made to Harvest Moon and VIDA. Mark will ask Erin to publish that the proceeds from the Oct. 29 breakfast will go toward the ultrasound machine so that the breakfast patrons will know what their donations will be used for.
- The next porkie pancake breakfast will be Oct. 29.
- **Next meeting will be after the breakfast on Oct. 29.**
- After a motion by Vic and seconded by Fred to adjourn, the meeting adjourned at 11:43 AM, closing with the Father McGivney prayer.
