 - a. Registration for next year begins Sunday. Renee is busy giving tours.
 - b. We are offering a third 3K option next year for 5 days per week.
 - c. Lots of fun activities planned for Catholic Schools Week next week.
- b. Home and School-Liz/Nicole:
 - a. Culver's fundraiser did very well, made \$3,802, a little more than last year.
 - b. We are planning to do the Uncle Mike's fundraiser again this winter along with a bowling event in place of golf outing for a more family-friendly feel.
 - c. There is interest in some sort of shade structure for the playground area so we are just starting to look at potential options for that.
- c. Buildings & Grounds:
 - a. B&G is looking into the potential purchase of a \$2,500 floor cleaner.
 - b. Mark is working with Erin on creating a plan for future-year projects. B&G would like to have a baseline budget of \$90K per year.
